OBEDIENCE, TRACKING AND ENDURANCE COMMITTEE

aka OTEC

OTEC is an elected sub-committee of DOGS Victoria, elections are held every two years whereby half the Committee step down but may stand for re-election, Terms of office are for four years. This gives the committee stability. There are seven positions on the Committee

Prior to each election a notice is published in the Gazette section of the DOGS Victoria magazine , calling for nominations and also advising how DV members may apply to be on the electoral role to vote for OTEC – conditions apply which mean that only those with an active or long-term interest in OTEC activities may vote

The next election year is 2016

OTEC oversees the conduct of Obedience, Rally Obedience, Tracking, Track and Search and Endurance on behalf of DOGS Victoria – this includes the training and ongoing oversight of Judges, and of the DV Obedience Instructors' Certification Scheme

OTEC also conducts several annual events- State Obedience Trial, including the Final of Top Obedience Dog of each year, State Rally Trial, State Tracking Trial plus the Easter Obedience / Rally Trials and the OTEC / Friends of Obedience Rally and Obedience Trials each November.
