Catalogue: Will be emailed to entrants prior to the event.

- Entries must have correct spelling of dog's pedigree/registered name and include all dog's titles so correct details of entry can be included in the catalogue.
- Your dog must be inspected by YOUR VET within the 2 weeks immediately prior to the ET, and the Certificate of Soundness form completed and signed by the vet and presented on the day of the trial. Your dog will not be permitted to compete unless the form is completed within two weeks of the trial, i.e. NOT before 26 August. The Certificate of Soundness form can be downloaded from the AMCV website: www.amcv.org.au
- The Endurance Test is open to dogs of all breeds that are ANKC registered (main, limited or associate register), whose owners are VCA members. All handlers must be members of Dogs Victoria.
- Dogs must be over 2 years of age and no older than 8 years of age.
- The handler may jog the distance, ride a push bicycle or tricycle or one powered by battery, provided the required speed is maintained (please indicate on entry form).
- All entrants who choose to ride a bicycle must wear a high-visibility vest and a suitable safety helmet to comply with the State traffic laws. All bicycles must be in roadworthy condition.
- If you plan to RUN with your dog, you will have to run at a 10 km per hour speed for 2 hours. That is quite fast, so please check that you can maintain this pace for the full distance before participating in the trial.
- Dogs must compete wearing a fixed collar or harness. Haltis and correction chains are not permitted.
