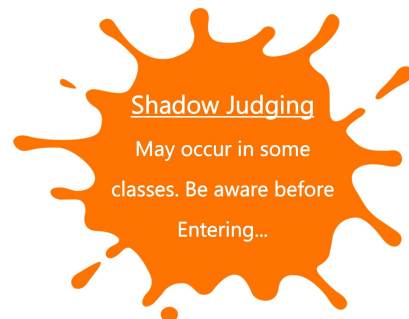

NFC-You will need to clearly indicate to the judge you are running under NFC when you enter the ring by using 2 arms in the air making an X. No pass can be obtained with dogs running as NFC. No food allowed in the ring, if toys are used, they must be small, noiseless, and not leave the handler's body.

The course must be run in numerical order as designed by the judge however you can start from whatever number in the course you like PLEASE NOTE: Each NFC run will have a maximum time of the SCT in the ring or if the Judge asks you to leave ring you MUST do so immediately.
