- Open to handlers under the age of 18, parent or guardian must be present
- Run over a Novice level course
- Dogs of any level eligible to be handled
- · Entries accepted on the day

STATE TRIAL FINALS QUALIFIERS

• Each height class will have the following number of (qualifying) placegetters who will automatically qualify for the finals:

200	1 st place	-	3 teams into the finals
300	1 st and 2 nd places	-	6 teams into the finals
400	1 st and 2 nd places	-	6 teams into the finals
500	1 st to 4 th places	-	12 teams into the finals
600	1 st and 2 nd places	-	6 teams into the finals

- The remaining finalists for each class will be chosen on a points-based system accumulated from all three heats. Dogs with the greatest number of points will rank the highest.
- Points will be allocated as follows (qualifying round only):

2 nd place	10 points	5 th place	7 points	8 th place	4 points		
3 rd place	9 points	6 th place	6 points	9 th place	3 points		
4 th place	8 points	7 th place	5 points	10 th place	2 points		
11 th place onwards 1 point							

- If two or more dogs are tied on the same score and are competing for the last spot in the finals in their height, they will both be eligible to qualify.
- Finalists will be announced after the Dash for Cash event on Sunday. Competitors cannot be individually contacted to be informed of their place in the finals.
- If a dog who qualifies for the finals does not compete in the finals for any reason, no substitution will be permitted.
- Dogs do not need to be entered in all 3 heats to qualify for the finals.
