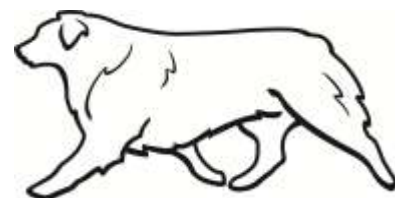

Vetting/Check In Times:

Trial competitors 8:00 -8.15 am both days (unless heat policy enacted then see times below)

Test competitors 9.30 – 10.30 am Sunday (unless heat policy enacted then see times below)

NB: Competitors MUST check in during these times to compete in tests and trials

EXTREME HEAT:

If the forecast temperature for either trial day is to exceed 30 deg Celsius (as per the Bureau of Meteorology website – District Forecasts/Central District/Wonthaggi) the trial will BEGIN at 7am and suspend trialling once the temperature reaches 30 deg C and recommence when the temperature drops below that point. If extreme heat action is taken, check in will be at 6.45 for for trial sheep exhibitors and 8.30 for test exhibitors.

Awards: Certificates to all qualifiers, rosette and prize for first place qualifiers.

Versatility award: Highest Combined Score over two types of stock

Versatility award: Highest Combined Score over three types of stock

The committee reserves the right to substitute Judges, suspend tests, change venue at any given time or to cancel a class if less than 3 entries are received o due tor unavailability of stock.
