



COVIDSafe Plan for

Bairnsdale (BDDOC) Agility & Jumping Trial 27th February 2021

[Approved by Dogs Victoria 21/2/21]

- Covid Marshall will be Marlene Hardy who will ensure all practices are carried out.
- All competitors and stewards to fill in Contact tracing Record Sheet on arrival at check-in.
- Social distancing signs are located around grounds and marked on ground.
- Hand sanitisers freely available at entry table, outside ring and around the grounds
- Toilets will be cleaned hourly.
- Competitors must park with a 3 metre gap between vehicles.
- Gazebos must be 1.5 meters apart.
- No competitors will enter the scribe's tent.
- Competitors will not congregate outside the rings and social distancing must be kept.
- Ring steward will ensure competitors social distance outside the ring.
- Handlers must put their lead in their pocket or wear it on their body.
- Only the Ring steward will replace dropped bars or change equipment height.
- Set up, course changes and packup will be carried out by a team of rostered volunteers. Disposable gloves will be provided.
- VCA Rep will be Trevor Pilinger.
- No presentation. Qualification cards will be made available outside the office when a class has been completed.
- Judges will limit the time for course walking to 10 minutes. Ten people to walk the course at one time.
- Judges will maintain social distancing with competitors.
- Catering will be provided for 2 judges and stewards. Food will be individually plated and served.
- No food available to competitors.
- All activity will be conducted outdoors.
- Trial secretary in the office and kitchen workers inside to wear masks.
