JUDGES:

JELENA KRUSS: CONFORMATION

Jelena Kruus, FCI judge (CAC/CACIB) Championship Show Judge.

One of the founders of Estonian Dalmatian Club. The chairperson of Estonian Dalmatian Club from 1997 to 2000, member of Estonian Dalmatian Club, Member of Finnish Dalmatian Club, Croatian Dalmatian Club and Belgian Dalmatian Club. Member of Managing Committee of the Judges of Estonian Kennel Union from 2005 till 2010.



Jelena has been involved with pedigree dogs since 1980. Her small hobby kennel, Exlibris Canes, was established 15 years ago, with husband, Margus & Ella Kasman (Borzois & Salukis). Jelena acquired her first Dalmatian Bitch, EST CH Seyla, in 1993. Jelena's kennel produced its first Dalmatian litter in 1995. Exlibris Canes Kennel has produced 14 dalmatian litters to date.

In 1996 Jelena purchased a very nice stud male from Finland - Caesands Moonlight Shadow (Carriage To Accomac -Town x Caesands Zmiling Star) - INT & Multi Ch., father of more than 100 puppies in Estonia, Lithuania and Russia. This dog won Estonia's TOP Dalmatian 1 in 1998 & 1999, Best Stud Dog- 3rd among all breeds in Estonia in 2000.

In 1999 Jelena brought another stud dog from Finland - Ottopojan Pataässä (Dalmo`s Irish Coffee x Rillan) – who attained INT & Multi Ch – this dog is sire of 100 puppies in Estonia, Finland, Latvia, Lithuania and Russia. He was Estonia's TOP Dalmatian I in 2000 & 2001 and TOP Dalmatian 2 in 2002 & 2003.

Offspring of both dogs have been used in Jelena's breeding program, along with males from kennels Dalmo`s, Ottopojan, Retma, Kamilkan, Lacrima Christi, Bell-A-Mir`s.

Jelena has 9 Dalmatians with International Beauty Champion titles (6 of them bred at Exlibris) and 27 Dalmatians with Champion titles from different countries (23 bred at Exlibris). The most successful Dalmatian bred by Jelena was Exlibris Canes Cosi Fan Tutte (Retma Papparazzi x Beautybarbara) - INT & Multi Champion and Multi Winner. She was TOP Dalmatian I in 2002 & 2003 in Estonia, and *first Dalmatian International Beauty Champion born in Estonia*.

Exlibris dogs took part in several European and World Winner Dog shows in 1999, 2000, 2001, 2005, 2006, 2008. More information about Exlibris Kennel and Jelena's dogs can be seen at Exlibris homepage

Currently Jelena has 4 Dalmatians, who live as members of family, with a further 5 Dalmatians in co-ownership.

Jelena has been judging since 2000. Jelena has judged Dalmatians (including Dalmatian Specialty) in Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, Finland, Sweden, Belgium, Denmark, Croatia, Russia, Belarus, Poland and Ukraine. Jelena judged at the prestigious European Cooperation Of Dalmatian Clubs - 2007 in Zagreb (Croatia).

Jelena is qualified to judge FCI Groups 4, 6, 10 and some breeds from Groups 2, 5, 7 and 8.

NOELINE MCILROY: OBEDIENCE

Not many people know my secret, I nearly owned a Dalmatian once. In 1985 my family were looking to replace a loved old dog and I had decided on a Dalmatian. Sadly there wasn't a puppy to be had in Victoria and in those days people didn't go very far or wait very long for a family dog. We had just had a holiday on a host farm so I was talked into looking at Border Collies by my younger daughter who had loved the farm dogs we met. The rest is history, but oddly, it was my older daughter who was to become the successful breeder, exhibitor, and at one time, trainer of Border Collies and I have dabbled in everything.



My love of Obedience started when the breeder of our new Border Collie puppy strongly recommended joining an Obedience club with him. Despite his handler, he went on to gain UD and thus the journey commenced. There have been six more titled since then, most going on to UD and Obedience Champion, plus Tracking Champion with three, two Herding Started titles and even an Agility one when I was more nimble. I am currently training two puppies in Tracking, their Obedience and Herding will come later when they have grown up a bit.

Whilst all this has been going on I have attained all Obedience judging licences and have judged in Tasmania, ACT, and NSW as well as regularly in Victoria. I am very active on the Obedience, Tracking & Endurance Committee of DOGS Victoria, on the Herding Committee and the Committee of Management and manage to be trial secretary of several events during the year, especially small "boutique" restricted trials which I enjoy most.

My admiration of Dalmatians continues despite not having managed to buy one. I guess it is their athletic fit for function structure, eagerness to do something, and that infinite variety of spots that catches my eye. I have judged them at all levels and seen some fine work and excellent handling. I am very much looking forward to judging at the Dalmatian National in 2012 and wish all exhibitors a very successful time in the ring and, above all, a great day out with their great canine companions.
