2022 DOGS VICTORIA JUMPING TOP DOG

Selection for the award will be made on the following basis:

- 1. Competitors will nominate up to 10 Master and/or Elite Jumping qualifying passes.
- 2. Passes will be gained from any Master and/or Elite Jumping Class of your dog's height with the following restrictions:
 - a. A maximum of three (3) passes gained from interstate.
 - b. Passes from Restricted Trials are not eligible.
- 3. Placings will be in accordance with ANKC Agility Rules.
- 4. Passes are to be gained at Trials between 15th November 2021 and 31st October 2022.
- 5. Interstate passes must be nominated and copies sent to the Agility Committee prior to Oct 31st 2022. Proof of other passes obtained may be required upon request.
- 6. Competitors must be residents of Victoria.
- 7. Dogs must be registered with Dogs Victoria Inc.
- 8. The "Top Dog Jumping Final" is to be conducted in conjunction with the State Agility Trial in 2022, it will be based on one round of a Master Jumping Class and will be run in heights.
- 9. The Agility Committee will select finalists based on the highest team scores and invite the required number of teams up to a maximum of 20 dogs.

The actual number of qualifiers in each height group will be calculated based on the number of dogs scoring passes in Master and Elite Jumping classes in the current Top Dog year, placings eligible for inclusion will be the same as the number of dogs qualifying in each height.

10. Passes will be assigned a point value with a maximum of 150 points possible. Points will be assigned as follows:

	Elite	Master
1 st	15 points	10 points
2 nd	13.5 points	9 points
3 rd	12 points	8 points
4 th	10.5 points	7 points
5 th	9 points	6 points
6 th	7.5 points	5 points
7 th	6 points	4 points
8 th	4.5 points	3 points
9 th	3 points	2 points
10 th	1.5 points	1 point

A minimum of 7 **eligible** passes for Top Dog Points is required (see table above); therefore, it is not automatically guaranteed that each height shall be represented in the final.

There will be no reserves allocated.

If scores are equal (within the height), qualifiers will be determined by a count back of 1st places, 2nd places etc. Additional pass cards may be included for this purpose however not all may be used as the highest pass submitted from each will determine the winner on a pass by pass basis.

Note: Trial Secretaries must ensure that their results are correct on K9entries, as this data will be used by the Committee to determine qualifiers. If the results in K9entries are incorrect for any reason, correct details must be sent to the Agility Committee.
