*Denotes courses (All Novice courses) where handler may nominate for NFC. Handlers are responsible for informing the steward prior to entry to the ring that they intend to run as NFC, and handlers must also inform the judge they are competing as NFC as they walk in the ring with a crossed hand signal. Handlers must run the course in numerical order and will have the standard course time to complete their run. Toys (but no food) may be taken in the ring, toys must be small, noiseless, and not leave the handler's body. If asked to leave the ring, the handler must do so immediately and without question.
