WEATHER POLICY

In the event of the temperature reaching 24oc at any time during the test on the 26th August 2023 this fixture would be cancelled in compliance with ANKC rules. Dogs Victoria Extreme Weather Regulations will apply.

ENDURANCE TEST REQUIREMENTS

EXHIBIT/DOGS

The Endurance Test is open to all breeds registered on the main, limited, and associate registers. In compliance with ANKC Rules Dogs must be over 2 years of age and no older than 8 years of age on the day of the test.

EXHIBIT/DOGS NAMES

The correct spelling of dog's pedigree/registered name and all dog's titles are to be included on the entry form so the correct details of entry can be included in the trial catalogue.

VETERINARY CERTIFICATE OF SOUNDNESS

Each dog must be inspected by your vet in the 2 weeks immediately prior to the Endurance Test date and a Certificate of Soundness form completed by your vet. You will need to bring and present your completed certificate of soundness certificate on the day of the test. Your Dog will not be permitted to compete unless the certificate is completed within two weeks of the test (NOT before 12th August 2023)

VETERINARY CERTIFICATE OF SOUNDNESS FORM

A blank copy of the Certificate of Soundness required for the test will be available from wssdavic@gmail.com

EQUIPMENT

The dog must wear a fixed collar or suitable harness. No neck chains, slip collars, spiked collars, muzzles, or head control collars permitted.

The leash must be long enough to be held in either hand so that the dog may adjust itself to the cyclist or runner. The dog shall travel at a suitable pace on the leash on the left-hand side of the handler or bike.

The springer device for attachment to a bicycle is not permitted.
No protective clothing may be worn by the dog.

The handler may jog the distance or ride a bike provided the required speed is maintained. Indicate clearly if you intend to RUN or RIDE or RIDE POWER ASSIST with your dog.

Please note that once you start to run you cannot change to using a bike.
All bicycles must be in roadworthy condition.

The venue is not suitable for Trikes (narrow bollards on bridge of course)

HANDLERS

All handlers must be current members of Dogs Victoria or other state affiliate and the member's number noted on the entry form.

Handlers may cycle or jog (please indicate on entry form)

Cyclists must wear enclosed shoes, a helmet, and a high visibility vest.

Runners must wear enclosed shoes and a high visibility vest.

All handlers are required to wear a high visibility vest for the entirety of the test.

All high visibility clothing and helmets used in the test must comply with Australian Safety Standards.

Please ensure all handlers are "fit" as a dog will fail if the handler cannot complete the distance.
