2017 DOGS VICTORIA JUMPING TOP DOG

Selection for the award will be made on the following basis:

- 1. Competitors will nominate up to 15 Master Jumping qualifying passes.
- 2. Passes will be gained from any Master Jumping Class of your dog's height with the following restrictions:
 - Passes must be from all running the same course with varying SCT only. If the course is different to other heights, then the pass does not count (ANKC Agility Nationals the only exception)
 - b. Maximum of three (3) passes gained from interstate.
 - c. Passes from Restricted to Breed, Height or Group Trials are not eligible.
- 3. Placing' s will be in accordance with ANKC Agility Rules
- 4. Passes to be gained at Trials between 1st August 2016 and 31st July 2017.
- 5. Include photocopies of all nominated passes and a completed ANKC entry form.
- 6. Competitors must be residents of Victoria.
- 7. Dogs must be registered with Dogs Victoria Inc.
- 8. The "Top Dog Final" is to be conducted in conjunction with the State Agility Trial in 2017 and will be based on one round of a Master Jumping Class. All heights will compete on the same course with a standard course time set based on the rate allocated to a 200 dog.
- 9. Results to be submitted to the Agility Committee which will select up to 14 finalists (see table below) based on the highest points within each height.

Note: Figures above have been calculated using the approximate percentage that each height represented in the State Trial Masters Agility class from the prior year.

The same percentage will be used to allocate points within each Masters Class:

10. Passes will be assigned a point value with a maximum of 150 points possible. Points are assigned as follows:

1^{st}	10 points	6 th	5 points
2 nd	9 points	7^{th}	4 points

A minimum of 5 **eligible** passes for Top Dog Points is required (see table above); therefore, it is not automatically guaranteed that each height shall be represented in the final.

There will be no reserves allocated.

If scores are equal (within the height), qualifiers will be determined by a count back of 1st places, 2nd places etc. Additional pass cards may be requested for this purpose however not all may be used as the highest pass submitted from each will determine the winner on a pass by pass basis.
