A - B - CAll-rounder Border Collie... ...easy as 1 - 2 - 3!

After watching the Aussie Shepherds compete for the Most Versatile Aussie over the years, we have decided to introduce an all-rounder competition for Border Collies to our restricted to breed performance showcase weekend. AS well as being a heap of fun, this will be a great opportunity for those heading to the Nationals to do some preparation for the Most Versatile Border Collie competition that is offered there later this year.

When and where – 25 and 26 May 2024 at KCC Park (see schedule for times)

Where do I enter – Top Dog Events will have a field where you can enter the ABC along with any of the performance events on the weekend. Entry for the ABC award is \$10. If you are entering a qualifying score from an event that is not held on 25-26 May, please email a copy of the relevant pass card to the Trial Secretary prior to 20 May 2024.

What do I have to do to be eligible — Gain a qualifying score or pass in three of the specified performance events. In the case of events offered on the day, those passes must be earned at our Restricted to Breed weekend. In recognising that many Border Collies may have earned passes in events that would be difficult or impossible to run on the weekend, we will accept passes earned in any of the other specified disciplines during the twelve months prior to the showcase weekend. In addition, to be eligible for the ABC award, dogs must enter and obtain a score in the Conformation Assessment held on 25 May.

What is the Conformation Assessment – each dog entered in the ABC will be assessed and scored against the breed standard by an experienced Border Collie breeder/owner or a trainee Dogs Australia judge. The assessment will include a physical examination of the dog's structure, visual appearance and movement (similar to what would happen at a dog show.)

How is the winner and placings of the ABC award determined – the winner will be determined by adding up a scaled score for the three performance qualifying scores based on level and score obtained plus the scaled score from the conformation assessment. The dog with the highest score will be awarded the ABC. In the event of a tie, the dog with the higher score in the conformation assessment will be awarded the higher placing.

Awards – all dogs that qualify for the ABC award will receive a rosette to acknowledge their achievement. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will receive a rosette.
