**NOTE** All dogs must be vetted by the Trial Veterinarian before the official start time of the Endurance Test. The Willingness Test, under Judge supervision, can only commence once the individual vetting is finished.

**CERTIFICATE OF SOUNDNESS FORM** Your dog must be inspected by your vet in the 2 weeks immediately prior to the Endurance Test date and a Certificate of Soundness form completed by your vet. Download a copy from the WSSDAVI website or a copy can be emailed by request to wssdavic@gmail.com (Do not complete vet check/certificate of soundness prior to 11<sup>th</sup> July 2026).

**WEATHER/EXTREME WEATHER** In the event of the temperature reaching 24 degrees Celsius at any time during the test, this fixture will be cancelled in compliance with ANKC Endurance Test rules. Dogs Australia Rules for the Conduct of Endurance Test (General Rule 7) and Dogs Victoria Regulations 9.1.3 and 9.6 will apply.

**DISABILITY/HEALTH CONCERNS** If you have a disability, hearing impairment, vision impairment or health condition, please contact the Trial Secretary to discuss your personal requirements prior to the day of the trial

**EXHIBIT/DOGS** The Endurance Test is open to all breeds registered on the main, limited, and associate registers. In compliance with ANKC Rules Dogs must be over 2 years of age and no older than 8 years of age on the day of the test.

**EXHIBIT/DOGS NAMES** The correct spelling of dog's pedigree/registered name and all dog's titles are to be included on the entry form so the correct details of entry can be included in the trial catalogue.

**VETERINARY CERTIFICATE OF SOUNDNESS FORM** Each dog must be inspected by your vet in the 2 weeks immediately prior to the Endurance Test date and a Certificate of Soundness form completed by your vet. Complete and email the Certificate of Soundness to the Trial Secretary. Your Dog will not be permitted to compete unless the certificate is completed by your Veterinarian within two weeks of the test (NOT before Saturday 11 July 2026). ## HANDLERS

- All handlers must be current members of Dogs Victoria or other state affiliate and the member's number noted on the entry form.
- Handlers may cycle or jog (please indicate on entry form) Bicycles must be roadworthy.
- Cyclists must wear enclosed shoes, a helmet, and a high visibility vest.
- Runners must wear enclosed shoes and a high visibility vest.
- All handlers are required to wear a high visibility vest for the entirety of the test.
- All high visibility clothing and helmets used in the test must comply with Australian Safety Standards.
- Please ensure all handlers are "fit" as a dog will fail if the handler cannot complete the distance.

## EQUIPMENT

- The dog must wear a fixed collar or suitable harness. Dogs to be on lead/crated at times.
- No neck chains, slip collars, spiked collars, muzzles, or head control collars permitted.
- The leash must be long enough to be held in either hand so that the dog may adjust itself to the cyclist or runner. The dog shall travel at a suitable pace on the leash on the left-hand side of the handler or bike.
- The springer device for attachment to a bicycle is not permitted.
- No protective clothing may be worn by the dog.
- The handler may jog the distance or ride a bike provided the required speed is maintained.
- Indicate clearly if you intend to RUN or RIDE or RIDE POWER ASSIST with your dog.
- Please note that once you start to run you cannot change to using a bike.
- All bicycles must be in roadworthy condition.

This exhibition will be held under the rules and regulations of Dogs Australia and Dogs Victoria. White Swiss Shepherd Dog Association of Victoria Inc is affiliated with Dogs Victoria.
